Because when this community embraces its unique vibrancy and diversity it can achieve great things. When we are united we are brimming with pride and passion.

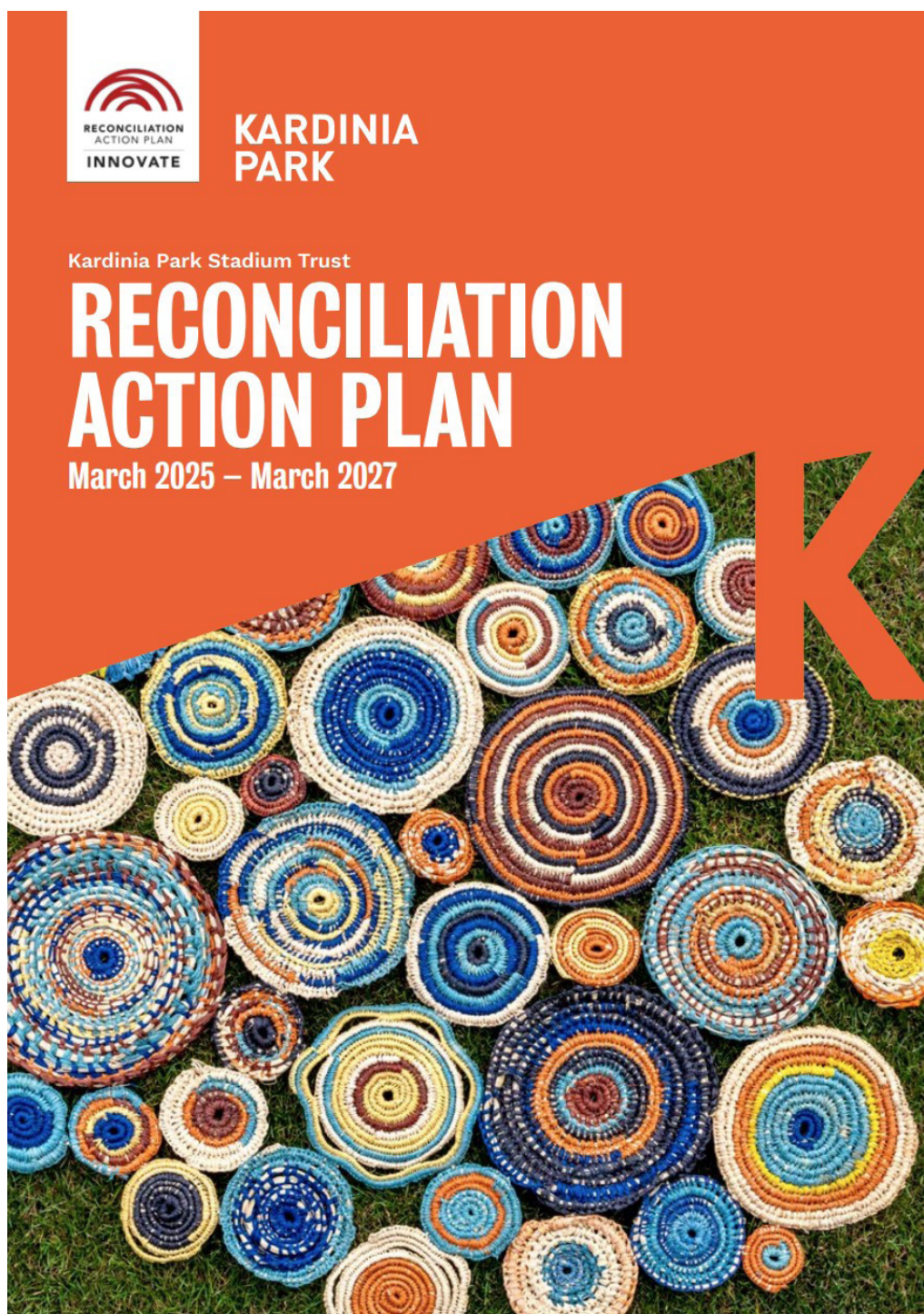

We invited community members to participate in consultation workshops, to ensure that our RAP captures the perspectives and needs of the local Aboriginal community.

These workshops provided opportunities for open dialogue and collaboration, and we gained invaluable insights and feedback. One of the highlights of our community engagement was the weaving workshops which provided a platform for participants to engage in a collective artwork that is permanently displayed at the Geelong Sports Museum and integrated into the final document as our RAP artwork “Weaving Connections”.
